# From Administration Division Member Bill Raymond:

Financial results thru 7/31/21

Collections for the year	\$ 320,264	\$ 246,616
Expenditures for the year	\$ 320,264	\$ 298,715
Amount over (under) needs	\$ 0	(\$ 52,099)

Likely because of the continued disruption in normal church operations resulting from the COVID pandemic, both expenditures and collections have fallen short of the budgeted amounts. Expenses are just over 9% below budgeted amounts, but collections this year-to-date are 23% below budget. Developing a budget for 2021 was almost impossible to forecast, as no one knew what to expect, and when we might be able to return to worship and other 'normal' activities. But in 2020, under similar circumstances, both expenses and collections were equally 10% below budget, keeping us from a deficit position. WBTS remains financially stable, and we are able to continue outreach programs and support of the Presbytery, and do not anticipate a need to take any drastic financial measures regarding expenditures in the foreseeable future. We thank you for the support of your church, and hope that you will continue to participate in and support your church through these difficult times.
